

ERS Paediatric Lifetime Achievement Award GUIDELINES 2010

Criteria (advertisement)

Through the support of Merck & Co., the ERS offers the Paediatric Lifetime Achievement Award in recognition of the awardee's services, teaching and education in Europe. A grant of €1,000 is offered. The Grant is exclusively reserved for ERS members 55 years of age or above at the time of application deadline. The applicant was a member of the ERS Paediatric Assembly for at least ten years. There will be a two years moratorium for previous awardees to be considered again.

Application

Application for the Award must be made through the online Paediatric Lifetime Achievement Award application form.

The candidate will have to provide

- The applicants must submit a resume.
- A conflict of interest declaration form (Industry and Tobacco) must be completed.

Evaluation/Selection

The candidate will be evaluated based on his/her achievements in the field of respiratory paediatric. A dedicated committee of reviewers, with specific expertise in the field will be nominated by the ERS Scientific Committee and chaired by the Research Director.

Grant Amount:

The Grant consists in €1,000 as a personal reward.

Presence

The presence of the Awardee at the Congress Ceremony is required. A short presentation of the candidate/projects' outcome etc. is scheduled in the programme. The presence of the company sponsoring the Award is encouraged. Official pictures will be taken.

A short presentation at the Congress, within one to two years after having been granted the prize may be required.

Limitations

There will be a two years moratorium for previous applicants to be considered again.
